

**a) Requirements for a Petroleum Road Tanker Driver Certificate:**

1. Identification Document (ID) for the applicant;
2. A valid certificate of fitness of the applicant from a doctor approved by the Directorate of Occupation Health and Safety Services;
3. A valid driving licence of the applicant;
4. A Police Clearance Certificate of the applicant (*should not be older than 1 year at the time of submission of the application*);
5. A colour Passport size photo of the applicant; and
6. Proof of training on defensive driving from a National Industrial Training Authority approved driving school.

**b) Online application procedure:**

To apply, visit the [Licensing Portal](#) on the EPRA website and follow the following steps:

1. Click “Create Account”;
2. Click on “License Management” then select “New Licence Application”;
3. Select the preferred Category in this case – *Petroleum Road Tanker Driver Certificate*;
4. Read and accept the licence conditions provided and click on “Proceed with registration icon”;
5. Follow the application process step by step by filling in the required information and click “Save”;
6. Attach the required documents as per the licence category; and
7. Submit the application.

**c) Requirement for renewal:**

1. Identification Document (ID) for the applicant;
2. A valid certificate of fitness of the applicant from a doctor approved by the Directorate of Occupation Health and Safety Services;
3. A valid driving licence of the applicant;
4. A Police Clearance Certificate of the applicant (*should not be older than 1 year at the time of submission of the application*);
5. A colour Passport size photo of the applicant; and
6. Proof of training on defensive driving from a National Industrial Training Authority approved driving school.

**d) Processing period, duration and charges:**

1. Applications for Petroleum Road Tanker Driver Certificates are evaluated within 30 calendar days from date of receipt.
2. The certificate is valid for a period of one year from the date of issuance.
3. No fees are charged for Petroleum Road Tanker Driver Certificates issued by EPRA.
