

PUBLIC NOTICE

PETROLEUM TANKER DRIVER'S CERTIFICATE

The Energy and Petroleum Regulatory Authority (EPRA) is established under Section 9 of the Energy Act, 2019 with a mandate of regulating, among others, the transportation of petroleum and petroleum products.

EPRA wishes to notify Oil Marketing Companies, petroleum wholesalers, petroleum retail station dealers, petroleum transporters and the general public that pursuant to Section 74(1)(d) of the Petroleum Act 2019, any person wishing to drive a petroleum road tanker, or engage a driver, for the purpose of transporting petroleum in bulk by road shall ensure that such driver is certified for that purpose by EPRA.

To apply for a *Petroleum Tanker Driver's Certificate*, the applicant should log in to EPRA's licensing portal on **www.epra.go.ke**. Thereafter register as a user, fill in the required details and attach the scanned copies of the necessary documents. A certificate will be issued to all qualifying applications within **fourteen (14)** days of submitting the application at no cost.

Accordingly, all petroleum road tanker drivers have up to 15th January 2020 to obtain the Driver's Certificate. Persons found in breach of the aforementioned requirement shall be liable to a fine of not less than two hundred and fifty thousand shillings, or to imprisonment for a term of not less than three years or both.
